



**Emerald Ash Borer**

**Japanese Beetle**


**Holes in ash bark made by insects**

**Ash Tree IDENTIFICATION**


Ash trees have:

- Compound leaves with 5-11 leaflets
- Opposite branching

**EAB only kills true ash trees, not mountain ash**
