Dendrochronology

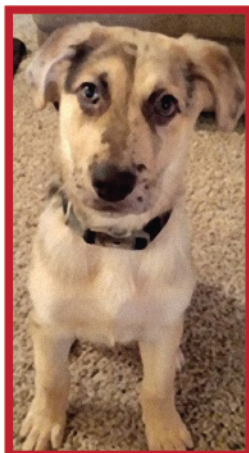
(den-droh-kruh-nol-uh-jee) is the study of data from tree ring growth. The technique can date wood to exact calendar years, and tell much about the climate of specific years.

Dendrochronology has been used to assist in the study of the following:

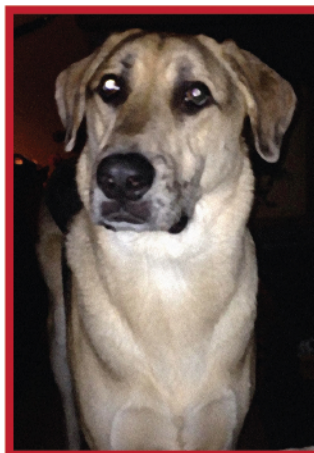
- Archeological ruins
