It's name is fudson Patto. any way he and I got up at 5:30, and had chow here befor leaving for chard. the sunday moving chow is really good here. This A.m. meliad two fried eggs (more of any thing it wanted) have breakfast food mellon. after chow eve got on the subway Cabout 2 blocks from the (+ otel) and affer shuttling a while got out to 121st and Broading. From these we walked one to the Riverside Church.

It is realy a Beautiful Church. Both inside and out. et was lustry that we arimed early (10:30) because it immediately started filling up. all during the service and even before I kept Thinking of you falk and armetrice simbarys of the past.
