Student Success Ecosystem

Illustrates the intentional environment created at UW-Stevens Point to support student success.

Retention Framework

Identifies high-level learning and behavioral outcomes for students in each year of their academic journey and describes the actions that faculty and staff members can take to support students in achieving those outcomes.

Major Maps

Major Maps help students learn how to build career-ready skills and experiences outside the classroom. Each Major Map shows how students can get the most of their UW-Stevens Point journey from enrollment to graduation and beyond. Major Maps supplement each student's four-year plan, which outlines the classes needed to complete the student's chosen degree.

Postsecondary Learning (PSL)

Postsecondary Learning (PSL) Courses offer targeted academic support with skills such as time management, test-preparation, note-taking, mindset, or goal setting to help students transition successfully to college and develop essential skills for college and professional success. Both 16-week and 8-week PSL courses are available throughout fall, spring, and summer semesters. Faculty and staff are encouraged to recommend PSL courses for students who may benefit from extra guidance in "studenting" skills.

Office of Institutional Research and Effectiveness (OIRE)

Provides official retention and student success data, including live dashboards, historic data, and Graduation Exit Survey results.

Navigate

Navigate provides a platform for coordinated student support. Faculty and staff can use Navigate to issue an alert, which will help students connect with resources like the Tutoring-Learning Center or the Financial Aid Office; to schedule appointments with students; and to create notes, appointment summaries, and progress reports that can be viewed by faculty and staff members such as advisors and coaches who support students' success.

Student Planner

Student planner helps advisors and students visualize, communicate, and plan for on-time graduation through a four-year planning tool in AccesSPoint.
