RECYCLING CHUTES

- **aluminum cans** We recycle ALL batteries!
- **glass** Drop your dead batteries
- **paper** off in the collection box in
- **plastic #1-7 & metal** your residence hall lobby.

Each month over 4,500 POUNDS of recyclables are collected from the UWSP residence hall recycling chutes.

CARDBOARD/STYROFOAM

Have *almost* dry, food-free cardboard (like those empty pizza boxes)? Bring the cardboard down to your lower level laundry room and we'll get it recycled. Styrofoam too, just make sure any packing peanuts are in a bag when recycled.

END OF YEAR

At the end of each spring academic semester, Residential Living collects unwanted good-condition usable resident clothing, non-perishable food items, and small appliances and donates them to local charities.
