ART 103 - Basic Drawing I

Description: Basic drawing in black and white from observation as a foundation for further study in the visual arts and design.

General Education Designation(s): GEP: ART

3 cr.

Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Students will draw from observation.
- 2. Students will design the picture plane and develop spatial illusion using 2D design principles and perspective techniques.
- 3. Students will analyze work in critiques and demonstrate critical thinking skills.
- 4. Students will demonstrate the fundamental skills of craftsmanship utilizing B&W media.
- 5. Students will document work.
