Course Information

CIS 345 DevSecOps in the Cloud with AWS examines the process of DevSecOps, or the integration of skills and technologies between Development, Security, and Operations. The basic structure of the course involves material here on the UWSP Canvas and material on the AWS Academy Canvas. More specifically, we will work through the AWS Academy Cloud Developing course in its entirety.

Learning Objectives

- Examine DevSecOps as a practice and process.
- Gain experience with Cloud technologies through Amazon Web Services (AWS).
- Use tools involved in DevSecOps processes.

The scores from AWS Academy will be used as the system of record for material that is completed within the AWS Academy site and the scores will be scaled up or down to meet the points in UWSP Canvas. It is your responsibility to ensure that the scores are correctly recorded within AWS Academy and that the score reflects the score that you believe you should have received in AWS Academy. If the score does not appear correct in AWS Academy, you should work with AWS Academy support after verifying that the issue is not related to your browser or device.

For assignments with material to be turned in, do not use Office 365 or attempt to "share" material through Canvas/Office 365, or any other application. You must upload a copy directly within the assignment on Canvas for it to be assessed. The only exception to this policy is for assignments that specifically prompt for URLs.

Coursework, if eligible to be submitted late, will typically receive a 50% points reduction if received up to 36 hours after its due date. Coursework submitted beyond 36 hours after the due date is not eligible for points. Additionally, certain coursework will have a strict due date after which late submissions are not accepted.

Remember: The Due Date is merely the <u>last time</u> when the work can be submitted. You can submit your completed work any time after it has been assigned.
