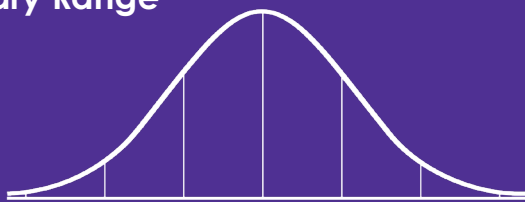
Work Environment

Mill supervisors work inside the mill most of the day. They will attend meetings, complete paperwork, and ensure the mill is operating efficiently. Mill supervisors may be required to work a rotating shift schedule.
