^{*}Depending upon placement. If you place into MATH 90, you will need an extra 3 credits somewhere in your plan to make up for that zero credit course. If you test into ENG 150, substitute an elective in one of the Written Communication spaces. If you test out of part or all of the World Language requirement, substitute an elective or requirement in one or both of those spaces.

You may count 3 credits of internship towards the major and up to 12 towards graduation. 40 hours of work experince for the internship counts as 1 credit, 80 hours as 2 credits, and 120 hours as 3 credits. Many students take emultiple internships.

⁺A minor is not required, but is strongly encouraged. Most minors require 18-24 credits.

Total credits may vary depending on selected electives. 120 minimum credits are required for graduation from UWSP.

Complete a two-semester sequence of university entry-level world language courses (101, 102). The requirement may be fulfilled through equivalent coursework or other language acquisition as demonstrated through a test-out policy (including Native American languages and American Sign Language). If your native language is not English and you can document formal high school or university study of your native language, then you may use ENGL 101 and ENGL 202, or ENGL 150 as a means of fulfilling this world language requirement.
