**SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

1. The acceptance of credits applies only to this Program-to-Program Articulation.
2. For acceptance of equivalent courses, FVTC courses must have been completed within the last 5 years. Beyond this period of time, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
3. This agreement is subject to review if either FVTC or UWSP undergoes curriculum revision OR within five years of the origination date of this agreement, whichever occurs earlier.

**This agreement is effective May 1, 2022 and will apply to students who complete the FVTC Family and Consumer Sciences Education Instruction A.A.S. degree after that date.**
