CAREER EXPLORATION DAY

Logistics:

The format is Open House, so students will move freely throughout our buildings, exploring Career Clusters and attending short informational sessions. (See reverse side for the Career Clusters.)

Each student will receive the following:

- A "swag bag" to corral all the things they will collect at the event.
- A map with Career Cluster locations.

Upon arrival, one of our staff will hop on your bus, hand out maps and bags. We will give your students a 3-minute overview of the event and what to do next.

Finding the right college fit sessions led by UW-Stevens Point staff and students will be held in the main academic building's auditorium Room #133. There are 3 sessions: 11:30, 12:30, and 1:30, followed by a panel discussion with current college students, about the college experience Please attend the session we have assigned your school. Space is limited in the auditorium. See separate attachment for your session time.

- Buses can arrive as early as 11 am. With 14 schools attending, we will welcome and get instructions to each school as efficiently as we can. There will be 2 drop off times (11am and 12pm), as well as 2 pickup times (1pm and 2pm). Schools highlighted in yellow are encouraged to arrive at 11am and depart at 1pm. Schools highlighted in green are encouraged to arrive at 12pm and depart at 2pm. This is only a suggestion; we know each school has a schedule they must adhere to. Schools are also welcome to attend the entire time.
- Schools are being assigned to one of two drop off / pick up locations (see Group A, Group B, and Group C just below).
- Remain on your bus until our staff member has given their quick overview.

- **Group A schools:** Lakeland Union, Mercer, Bowler, Faith Christian Academy, Wittenberg-Birnamwood, and Marathon.
- Start in our main academic building, entering at the south entrance.
- **Bus route:** Take Stewart Ave. toward campus, turn south onto 3rd Ave., then turn right (west) onto Garfield Ave.
- **Drop off/pick up:** Drop off and pick up students at the south entrance of our main academic building. Accessible entrance at southwest entrance. (See group A teardrop on the map)
- Bus parking: Park in Marathon Park.
- **Group B schools:** Elcho, White Lake, Prentice, Tigerton, Tomahawk, Newman Catholic, and Mosinee.
- Start in our UW Center for Civic Engagement (CCE) building, entering at the south entrance
- **Bus route:** Take Stewart Ave. toward campus, turn south onto 6th Ave., then turn right into FIRST entrance to Lot G.
- **Drop off/pick up:** In Lot G, drop off and pick up students at the south entrance of our CCE building. (See group B teardrop on map).
- **Bus parking:** Park along southern edge of Lot G or in Marathon Park if space is unavailable

Group C schools: Home school groups,

- WI Valley Lutheran, and Rural Virtual Academy Start in our main academic building.
- **Parking:** : Park in Marathon Park, then enter at our west entrance (See Group C teardrop on map). Check in at Solution Center, straight ahead as you enter.
