Since 1985 Ray has been conducting archaeological survey and fieldwork projects in Central Wisconsin, Australia, New Mexico, Utah, and Ontario, Canada.

Dr. Reser's interests include Late Pleistocene and Early Holocene hunter-gatherers in Australia and North America, rock art studies, lithic technology and sourcing, and the use of indigenous knowledge, sense of place, and origin stories to inform the archaeological record.
