 DAH within seven (7) days after you receive them
- DATCP DAH monitors and responds to regulatory animal diseases

FISH MOVEMENT

In-State Movement

- Fish Health Certificate may be required depending on the source and destination of the fish
- For stocking waters of the state, contact DNR for a DNR Fish Stocking Permit

Out-of-State Movement

- For movements into WI, a Fish Import
 Permit may be required along with a
 Fish Health Certificate
- DNR has requirements for importation of non-native species of fish
- For movements out of Wisconsin, contact the state of destination for specific requirements
