WHAT IS A THEMED COMMUNITY EXPERIENCE?

Themed Community Experiences (TCE) are intentional living environments offered to students by Housing and Residence Life in collaboration with campus partners. These community experiences offer learning opportunities for students to engage in a variety of activities to connect them to the university and to faculty/staff while providing a living space for students to connect what they are learning inside the classroom to their everyday life.

Members of Themed Community Experiences reside on a floor or wing of a residence hall designated for students that have been invited to live in that community. These community experiences offer a safe, supportive environment for students with similar interests, majors, and/or identities to live in. These environments allow students to make deep social connections by engaging with peers around shared educational experiences, and can improve participating students' academic success through intentional programming, co-curricular learning experiences, and faculty/staff engagement.
